Dear Newark Resident:

A dog or cat can be a great companion as well as a source of friendship and security for you and your family. Owning a pet also comes with responsibility. To keep your pet healthy and ensure the safety of our citizens, domestic animals are required to be registered with the City and have current rabies vaccinations.

Every owner of a dog or cat over 3 months of age in the City of Newark shall register the animal. To register your pet please bring or mail a current Rabies Vaccination Certification, issued by a licensed veterinarian, along with the completed registration form and fee to City Hall located at 209 Hudson.

The registration fee is \$5.00 per animal and \$3.00 for renewal each year.

You may pay by credit card, check or cash unless you are mailing the information then you must pay by check or money order. If you register by mail send payments to:

You will be issued a tag for your animal which is required to be worn on your pet's collar at all times. The tag will allow for easy identification and will be your lost pet's ticket home.

All pets must be registered by April 30, 2019 or the owner will be issued a citation with a fine of \$500.00 per City of Newark Code of Ordinances, Section 2.01.003. Renewal is required by May 1st of every year. If you have any questions, please contact me at 817-489-2201.
